



About Spiti

Located in the Northern state of Himachal Pradesh, 'Spiti Valley' or 'Lahaul-Spiti' as it is alternatively known, is a cold desert mountain valley famous for its panoramic landscapes and unexplored tourist spots. The word 'Spiti' literally translates into 'middle-land' in English, as it signifies the land between Tibet and India. One of the most sparsely populated regions in India, Spiti Valley is predominantly home to the Vajrayana Buddhism followers. Also regarded as the gateway to the mystical Ladakhi region, Lahaul-Spiti is directly accessible only by road for the general public during the summer months of April to October.

The Spiti Valley is surrounded by high mountain ranges on both sides as it is separated from the Kullu Valley in Himachal Pradesh by the Rohtang Pass (13,054 feet or 3979m), and Lahaul and Spiti are separated by the Kunzum Pass (15,059 feet or 4590m). Both the mountain passes are connected by the Leh-Manali national highway which often gets disconnected during the winter months due to excessive snowfall but Spiti is connected through shimla Kinnaur route.

TRIP SCHEDULE:

DAY 01 | ARRIVAL/PICKUP CHANDIGARH - VIA SHIMLA - NARKANDA/KOT-GARH

Our Winter Spiti Expedition will start from Chandigarh/Shimla Pickup and reach Narkanda by evening. Narkanda is almost 175km away from Chandigarh and it will take 4 to 5 hours. Volvo will be in charge of your comfort concerns during the overnight journey to Shimla and Narkanda is 65km away from Shimla and it will take 1/2 hours. That is all for the firtst day in Winter Spiti Expedition.

Distance Covered: 180-200 Kms Travel Time: 06-07 hrs Cab Meal: Dinner

DAY 02 | NARKANDA TO SANGLA

Today, Drive to Last Village of India Chitkul, as river Baspa will be at your right side. On the way you will pass through Rakcham village. The Indian road ends here. Chitkul is situated at 3450m height. Chitkul is the last Indian village on the India-China border and experience another beautiful valley. According to the Centre of Atmospheric Sciences at IIT Delhi, Chitkul has the cleanest air in India. Overnight stay at Chitkul/Sangla.

Distance Covered: 170-180 Kms Travel Time: 06-07 hrs Cab Meal: Breakfast and Dinner

DAY 03 | SANGLA TO TABO

By Morning after Breakfast, we will start our journey to Tabo. The destination is around 210 Km from Chitkul/Sangla and would take almost 7 hours. En route, we will cross through Sumdo Border and Ka loops. Tabo is famous for its ancient monastery; this monastery is awarded with World Heritage site by UNESCO in this Winter Spiti Expedition. Visit the Oldest Monastery in Spiti Valley which is Tabo Monastery. Overnight stay at Kaza.

Distance Covered: 85-100 Kms Travel Time: 04-05 hrs Cab Meal: Breakfast and Dinner

DAY 04 | TABO TO PIN VALLEY KAZA

Today, we will drive to Kaza, which is around 70 km away from Tabo. We will reach to Kaza by the afternoon. The old town is located on the outer edge of the city and the major attraction here is an ancient monastery in this Winter Spiti Expedition. Visit Hikkim, the location of the World's Highest Post Office. Komic, the Highest village connected by a motorable road in Winter Spiti. Also, Visit Langza very famous for the Buddha Statue.

Overnight at Kaza.

(NOTE:- Please note Road Conditions to - Gue Village are not good. If at the time of the travel roads are closed or not in good condition then will not cover the same. It's for Guest Safety Only).

DAY 05 | KAZA LOCAL

After breakfast We begin the fifth day, with a drive to renowned Ki Monastery. Then we will move farther up the valley to the picturesque village of Kibber. Located at a height of 4205 meters and 18 km from Kaza From Kibber we will head to the famous Chicham bridge - Asia's highest bridge. We will then drive to some of the highest inhabited regions of the world. Later we try to cover HikkimKmoic and tangza villages if road conditionsartarable overnight at Kaza In the evening, enjoy a forest-side bonfire experience with soulful music and a healthy, delicious dinner under the stars Overnight at Kaza.

Meal: Breakfast and Dinner

DAY 06 | KAZA TO KALPA

After breakfast in kaza, we turn around and head to Kalpa. Legend has it that Kalpa was the winter home of Lord Shiva. If it's true, he couldn't have found a more remarkable abode for himself, with enthrallingly majestic views of the Kinner-Kailash and Jordanian peaks looming right above the village. Accessibility during this time may vary depending on weather conditions. Overnight at a hotel in Kalpa In the evening, enjoy a forest-side bonfire experience with soulful music and a healthy, delicious dinner under the stars Overnight at Kalpa.

Distance Covered: 90-120 Kms Travel Time: 05-06 hrs Cab Meal: Breakfast and Dinner

DAY 07 | KALPA TO SHIMLA / CHANDIGARH DROP

The last leg of this 7 Day Winter Expedition is here. We drive for Shimla with a bag of delightful memories and exciting stories to recount. From snow-covered trails to cozy evenings, each moment has added to an experience we'll remember for years to come. We are expected to reach Shimla by 3:00 PM, and all participants will be dropped off near the Tourism Lift Parking area. To ensure a smooth and stress-free conclusion to your trip, we recommend planning your onward travel from Shimlaany time after 7:00 PM on the same day, or even better, the following day. This gives you ample time to relax and reflect on the journey. For those heading toward Chandigarh, you aisle have the option of hiring a private cab from Shimla. Tour End

- Itinerary may be modified or Changed, Completely depends upon the Weather and situation. We reserve the right to do the same and Guests have to agree with the same.
- All Sightseeing totally depends upon Weather, Road Condition and Time management of Guests. Sightseeing Can be Shifted on Other Days or can be missed, Totally Depends upon the Road conditions and time management of Guests.
- Due to Peak Season Time, Check-In to the Stay/Hotel will be Provided as perthe Stay/Hotel
 Check-In Policy. Standard Check-In Time is 12:00 Hrs. Early Check-In is Subject to availability
 and Totally Depends upon the Stay/Hotel Policy.
- For Complete Trip From the Starting till end, For Guest Safety, Security, Sightseeing, Etc. The Final decision is always from the Spiti Expedition/Driver side and all guests have to agree with that.
- In Some Places Guests have to do Hiking, So Kindly prepare for the same accordingly.
- Kindly Note Gue Mummy and Pin Valley Sightseeing totally depends upon the roads conditions. If at the time of travel it is not possible for the vehicle to cover the same, Then for Guests safety we will not cover the same Sightseeing.
- In Narkanda, Hatu Valley and Hatu Temple Sightseeing is not part of the Itinerary. Due to Union rules our vehicles can't cover the same as well astempo travelers are not allowed in Hatu Valley due to road Conditions. If guests want to coverthe same then they can hire the local taxis from the union on their own and they have to pay the charges for the same.
- Supplement Cost will be Chargeable For More Then 1 Pickup Point and More Than 1 Drop Point.
- Supplement Cost will be Chargeable For Pickup and Drop Shimla Airport, Shimla Railway Station, Kalka Railway Station.
- In Kalka Due to Local union Issues, Pickup can be Arranged from outside the Kalka Railway Station.
- In case if Roads are blocked and further journey is not possible then we will take the best possible decision for Guests Safety and guests have to agree for the same.
- Supplement Cost will be Chargeable for Any Other Sightseeing which is not mentioned in the itinerary.
- Kindly note at the time of Travel if Route will get closed or in bad conditions then will take
 alternative route with alternate Stay for the Guest safety but for that Supplement cost will be
 applicable which has to be borne by the Guests directly.
- In Case of Any Natural Calamity (Landslide, Strike Etc.) if we have to Shift or Increase the Stay at the particular Place then the Supplement Cost for the Same bear by the Guests Directly.
- We (Spiti Expedition) will not be responsible for any kind of damage or Loss During the Trip.
- Kindly note at the time of Travel if Kunzum Route will get closed or in bad conditions then will take an alternative route for the Guest safety but for that Supplement cost will be applicable which has to be borne by the Guests directly.
- In Case of Any Health or Medical Issues Or Emergency, If Guests have to Leave the Tour in Between then there is No Refund Policy. Guests have to pay Full Amount in this case as well. We can try to help Guests to Arrange Separate
 - Vehicles (For Transfers in Emergency), But Guests have to bear the Full Charges on their own.
- If Kunzum and Chandratal Route Both will be open then only will cover the same and head towards Manali. If Route is closed then it will take an alternative Route and will not cover these places.
- Meals (Breakfast & Dinner) will be provided in Stays only. No Meals can be packed.
- · Any kind of refund is not possible for any unused services.
- Please don't use Single use plastic bottles in Spiti, Carry Hard Steel water bottles for the trip.
- Spiti is a Destination which is off beat totally and growing nowadays. So you will not get any luxury stay at this type of place. It's a place for experience and exploration.

- Try not to carry plastic bags, it will harm the environment if it's come in contact with it.
- Do not tease or disturb the wildlife during your visit to the places in Spiti or else where.
